International Ozone Association Taps Water Industry Veteran

Paul Overbeck, a 30 year water and wastewater industry professional has become the Executive Director of the International Ozone Association (IOA).



The International Ozone Association is a Not-for-Profit, educational and scientific organization dedicated to the collection and dissemination of information on, and to promote research in, any and all aspects of ozone and related oxygen species technologies.

Mr. Overbeck was President of GDT Corporation and General Manager of Mazzei Injector Corporation's Industrial and Municipal group following the December 2004 GDT merger into Mazzei Injector Corporation. Previously, he was COO of Osmonics (now General Electric), responsible for OREC ozone, Lakewood Instruments and inorganic filtration divisions located in Phoenix, Arizona before founding GDT Corporation in 1996. He also held management positions at Culligan International, Arrowhead Industrial Water (US Filter), and with Polymetrics (US Filter) where he first got involved with ozone in 1982 with responsibility for the Welsbach Ozone Division.

Overbeck stated, "I feel my experience with multiple process technologies and application requirements will help IOA present the synergistic benefits ozone can bring to current and emerging market applications."

In that direction, the IOA will hold a technical conference focusing on municipal water and wastewater, commercial-industrial and food processing applications from 18-20 September 2006 and will join with the International Ultraviolet Association (IUVA) to hold a combined "Ozone-UV" World Congress from 25-30 August 2007.
